## **Delegate Code Of Conduct**

Alberta Municipalities is committed to providing a welcoming, inclusive and harassment-free environment for all persons attending the Convention ("Convention Participants"), regardless of gender, race, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, ethnicity, age, religion or any other legally protected characteristic.

The following guidelines apply to all facets of the Convention including sponsor hosted events, workshops, plenaries, political meetings and social gatherings where Convention Participants are in attendance.

Behaviours that are not acceptable at the Convention include:

- a . Harassment or intimidation based on personal characteristics such as gender, race, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, ethnicity, age, or religion .
- b. Sexual harassment or intimidation, including unwelcome sexual attention, stalking (physical or virtual), or unsolicited physical contact.
- c. Shouting down or the use of abusive, offensive, or threatening language towards Convention Participants .

If you experience or witness a Convention Participant demonstrating these behaviours, please report it to any one of the Alberta Municipalities' Board Members. Any Convention Participant found violating these rules may have their registration revoked and be asked to leave the Convention, without a refund, at the discretion of the CEO or designate.
