ABmunis introduces new EV Charging Program

February 5, 2025

EDMONTON – Alberta Municipalities (ABmunis) is pleased to introduce the Electric Vehicle Charging Program (EVCP), a program that will provide \$1.7 million in funding to successful applicants for the purchase and installation of EV charging stations in communities across Alberta.

Funding for this program is provided by Natural Resources Canada's (NRCan) Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure Program (ZEVIP).

Applicants can receive a rebate of up to 46 per cent to offset eligible project costs.

Applications will be accepted starting February 5. Funding will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. All applications will be assessed on their merits and must meet strict criteria.
