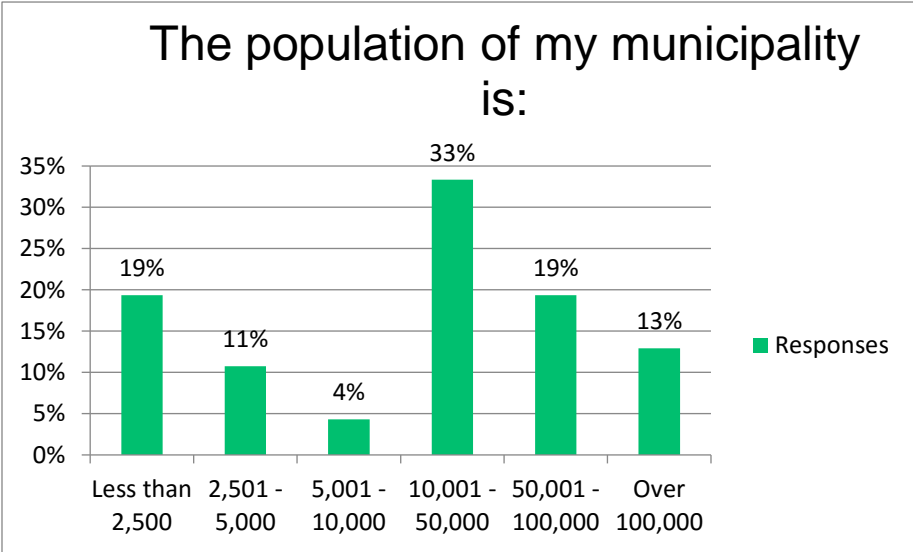
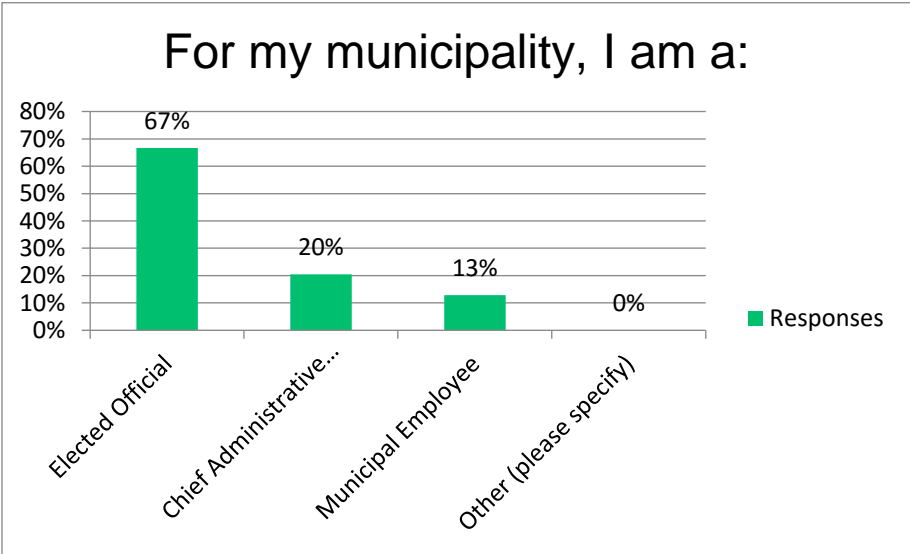

Introduction

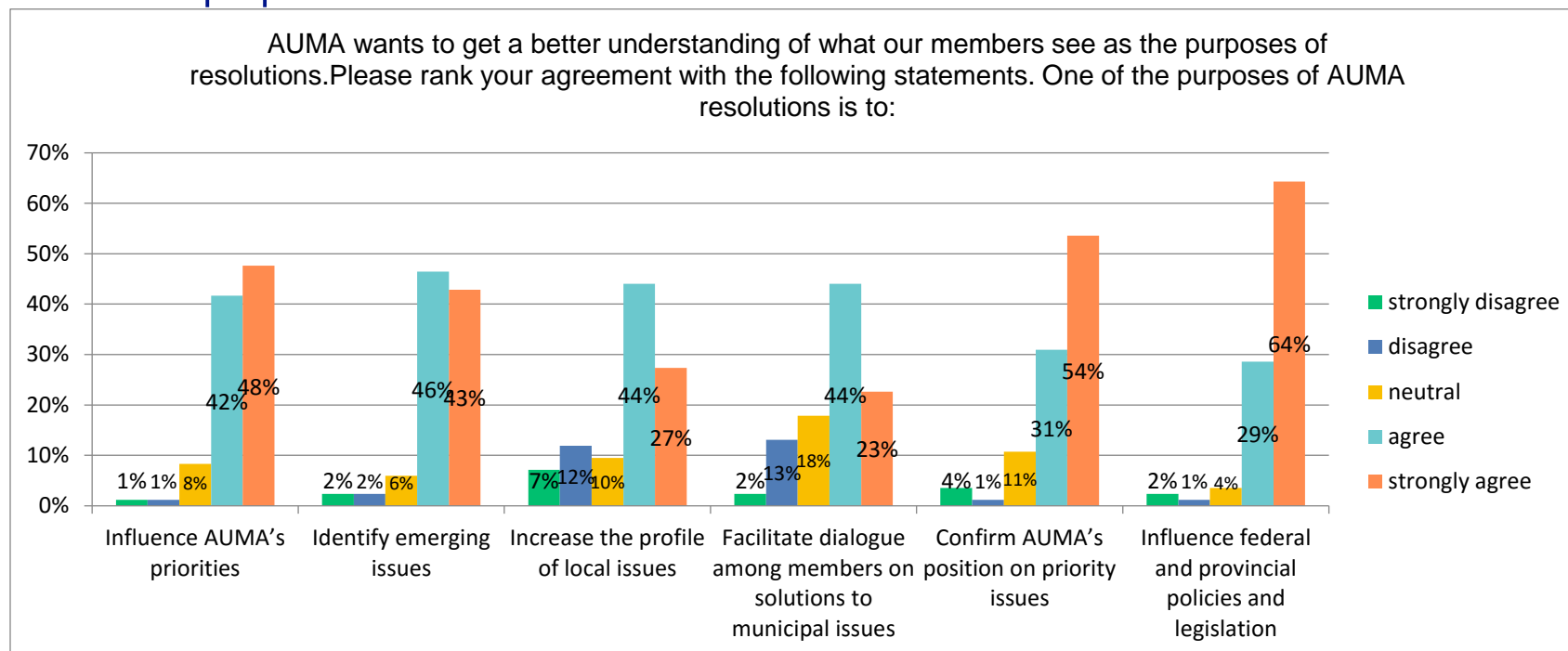
AUMA’s Municipal Governance Committee is reviewing our [Resolutions Policy](#) to determine how it can be updated to improve the impact and outcomes of the resolutions our members bring forward. We will present a new resolutions policy for consideration by members at AUMA’s Convention in September 2019. AUMA ran a survey from December 19 to January 17 to determine what members see as the purpose(s) of resolutions so that we can develop a policy that reflects the purpose(s).
